But, a couple of years later, Mrs. Pringle earned her General Educational Development (GED). After earning her GED, she began working as an aid at Bibb Medical Center Nursing Home. While gaining valuable work experience and skills at Bibb Medical Center, she discovered nursing was her passion. This discovery led her to enroll in the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) program in Birmingham, AL where she became a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

After graduation, Mrs. Pringle continued her service at Bibb Medical Center Nursing Home. As an LPN, Mrs. Pringle expanded her horizons by working under Doctor Lee at Perry County Hospital, Druid City Home Health Care, and Brookwood Hospital. After years of experience as an LPN under her belt, Mrs. Pringle knew she wanted to do more. Thus, she enrolled into Wallace State Community College's Nursing Program. In 1992, Mrs. Pringle earned her Registered Nurse (RN) license, becoming the first person in her immediate family to earn an Associate's degree. With the support of her husband and four children, she started her own home health care business. Mrs. Pringle was a woman that was committed to serving people through the medical field and her community. Not only was she a nurse, she was a tenacious entrepreneur, a powerful woman, a loving mother, and a beautiful wife.
